

Pen & Ink Class Supplies List

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Intermediate/Advanced Students: Scan the list, but bring what you are comfortable with.

Paper: Strathmore Bristol pads, vellum surface 9"x12" (or equivalent). A small, plain pad for pencil value sketches is also recommended.

Pen & Ink: I use a simple dip (nib) pen with replaceable nibs and I work with indelible Black India Ink. Many other pens are available, including fountain pens (which I always used when travelling). However, the Pigma Micron Pens with varying felt tip sizes are widely used today. You would want a very fine tip, a medium tip and a large tip.

Pencil: An HB (roughly equivalent to a standard No.2 pencil) is recommended.

Erasers: A kneaded eraser and a pink pearl eraser are handy.

Kleenex: Use to wipe the pen, protect the paper from your hand, soak up spills, and, of course, for its normal function.

You may bring your own photographs to use as subject matter, but I will always bring my own photograph with copies for you as well as a black and white with carbon paper for rough sketching.
